Application is hereby made on behalf of **CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the **Greenwood-Waskom Field**, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a pattern of drilling and production units was created by Office of Conservation Order No. 270-MM, effective June 19, 2007, as amended and supplemented by the 270-MM Series of Orders, to-wit:

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such unit to be designated HA RA SUD;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;

3. To designate a unit well for the proposed unit, if appropriate;
4. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of the proposed unit, if appropriate;
5. To extend to the proposed unit, the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 270-MM-2, effective September 16, 2008;
7. To extend to the proposed unit, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 270-MM, effective June 19, 2007, as amended and supplemented by the 270-MM Series of Orders; and
8. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, in the Greenwood-Waskom Field, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 270-MM-2, effective September 16, 2008, and is hereby redefined INsofar AND ONLY INsofar as to the unit designated HA RA SUD created herein, as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 9,828 feet and 11,145 feet, electric log measurements, in the Encore Operating Louisiana, LLC (formerly Greystone Oil & Gas, LLP) – Querbes No. 2 Well (SN 236852), located in Section 29, Township 16 North, Range 16 West, Caddo Parish Louisiana.

A conference to discuss the proposed application and any opposition thereto was held at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, November 24, 2008, at The Petroleum Club, 416 Travis Street, Shreveport, Louisiana. A list of the parties who attended the pre-application conference is attached. Jeremy B. Shealy, attorney for the applicant, opened the conference with a brief discussion on unitization. David Comeaux, geological consultant for the applicant, explained the applicant's proposal and the geological, engineering and other bases therefor, and answered questions. Opposition to the proposal was expressed at the conference. However, no counterplan was presented; thus, we are unable to anticipate whether there will be opposition at the hearing. Mr. Shealy then concluded the conference with a discussion of the Rules of Procedures. The conference was then adjourned.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation. However, the

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list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, enclosed herein is our check in the amount of \$755.00 made payable to the Office of Conservation in payment of the required hearing application fee.
