Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **MARITECH RESOURCES, INC.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A**, in the **Irene Field**, East Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana, to-wit:

1. To establish rules and regulations and create two (2) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate, such units to be designated TUSC RA SUA and TUSC RA SUB;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate Maritech Resources, Inc. as the operator of, and a unit well for each of the proposed units, if appropriate;

4. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A, within or outside of the proposed unit, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order 29-E;
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation; and
6. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.


The Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A, in the Irene Field, East Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 18,050 feet and 19,970 feet, electrical log measurements, in the South Louisiana Production Company, Inc. - SL 6890 No. 1 Well, located in Section 43, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, (WSN 170415) East Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana.

A conference to discuss the proposed application and any opposition thereto was held at 3:00 p.m. on May 11, 2009, at Onebane Law Firm, 1200 Camellia Blvd., Suite 300, Lafayette, Louisiana. A list of the parties who attended the pre-application conference is attached. Randall Songy, attorney for the applicant, opened the conference with a brief discussion on unitization and the Rules of Procedure. Louis Gilbert, geological consultant for the applicant, explained the applicant's proposal and the geological, engineering and other bases therefore, and answered questions. The conference was then adjourned. There was no formal opposition to the proposal expressed at the conference, but some parties expressly "reserved their rights" to oppose the Applicant's plan.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, enclosed herein is our check in the amount of \$755.00 made payable to the Office of Conservation in payment of the required hearing application fee.

Your receipt of this Application does not require you to take any action. It is meant to notify you of these proceedings so that you have the opportunity to participate if you so desire.


