APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

Questar Exploration and Production Company hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, and the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bossier and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana:

1. To create one additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bossier and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, to be designated CV RA SUR, as shown outlined on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To create one additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bossier and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, to be designated HA RA SUU, as shown outlined on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
3. To force pool and integrate all of the separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests located within the proposed units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate a unit well and unit operator, as appropriate;
5. To provide that with respect to horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in or to serve proposed HA RA SUU, where the horizontal lateral portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;
6. Except to the extent inconsistent herewith, to extend to the proposed units the provisions of (a) Office of Conservation No. 691-B, effective January 8, 2002, with respect to the

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Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, as amended and supplemented by the 691-B Series of Orders, (b) Office Of Conservation Order No. 691-C, effective November 18, 2008, with respect to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, as amended and supplemented by the 691-C Series of Orders, and (c) all applicable Statewide Orders;

7. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.

The Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bossier and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 691-B, effective January 8, 2002.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bossier and Bienville Parishes, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 691-C, effective November 18, 2008.





----- : PROPOSED UNIT


