Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of **CENCO, Inc.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Camerina 1 Sand, Reservoir I, Kaplan Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit applicant to utilize and designate the CENCO, Inc.-Hebert No. 1 Well as an alternate unit well for the CAM 1 RI SUA, such well to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit well is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the CAM 1 RI SUA which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within the unit;
3. To grant a single unit allowable for the CAM 1 RI SUA and to permit the operator of the unit to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the proposed alternate unit well, or from any combination at its option;
4. To redefine the CAM 1 RI SUA previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 557-E-22, effective October 24, 2006;
5. To confirm the unit established by Office of Conservation Order No. 557-E-22, effective October 24, 2006;
6. To confirm CENCO, Inc. as the operator of the CAM 1 RI SUA;

7. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation No. 557-E-22 shall remain in full force and effect;
8. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the sand and reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of each reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation, and
9. To consider such other matters which may be pertinent to this application as shown by the evidence presented at the hearing held on this matter.

The Camerina 1 Sand, Reservoir I, Kaplan Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 557-E-22, effective October 24, 2006 and is hereby redefined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 17,703 feet and 18,585 feet (electrical log measurements) in CENCO, Inc.-John E. Hebert No. 1 Well, located in Section 9, Township 12 South, Range 2 East, Vermilion Parish.

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, a pre-application conference was held in Lafayette, Louisiana on May 26, 2009. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a list of the names and addresses of the parties who were in attendance at that conference.

The conference was opened by Mr. B. J. Duplantis. Mr. Bill Robbins of W. H. Robbins & Associates presented the plan of applicant. Questions were asked and answered. Mr. Jim Hardwick on behalf of Romero presented a plan of 160 acres for the redefined area. It is anticipated that there may be opposition at the public hearing on this matter.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the CAM 1 RI SUA, showing the location of the alternate unit well together with a list of the names and addresses of all interested owners, interested parties and represented parties who are known to the applicant after reasonable search. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all such parties.

A copy of the list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties is not being mailed to those parties along with this hearing application. Should any such party desire a copy of this list, however, we will be glad to provide one upon request.

Upon receipt of the legal notice in the captioned matter, the notice will be posted, published and mailed in accordance with Rule 7 of the Rules of Procedure.


