Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **DAVIS PETROLEUM CORPORATION** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Miocene Zone, Reservoir A, in the Mallard Bay Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana, said proposed unit designated MIO RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate the Davis Petroleum Corporation – State Lease 19354 No. 1 Well as unit well for the proposed unit.
4. To designate Davis Petroleum Corporation as operator of the proposed unit.
5. To provide that any wells drilled to the Miocene Zone, Reservoir A, in Mallard Bay Field, within or outside of the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

7. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Miocene Zone, Reservoir A, in the Mallard Bay Field, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 5,700 feet and 6,702 feet (electrical log measurements) (5632 feet and 6489 feet true vertical depths) in the Davis Petroleum Corporation – State Lease 19354 No. 1 Well, located in Section 22, Township 13 South, Range 3 West, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.


A pre-application conference was held on May 27, 2009, in Lafayette, Louisiana, at which the parties named on the attached list were in attendance. The conference was opened by representatives of the applicant who explained the applicant's proposal. They explained that the proposed unit well was now completed, but because the deeper targeted sands within the original zone definition in this well were not productive, both the zone definition and unit proposal had been revised. Questions were asked and answered and the conference was then adjourned. Some support for the revised proposal was expressed, but opposition at the hearing is possible.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the applicant's proposal, along with a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom a copy of this application is being mailed.
