Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, BETHANY-
LONGSTREET FIELD, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

CORONADO ENERGY E&P COMPANY, L.L.C. ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana:

1. To create two (2) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such units being shown on the attached plat and being designated HA RA SUDD and HA RA SUEE.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed additional units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate an operator of, and unit well for, each of the proposed units as may be appropriate.
4. To redefine the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, insofar and only insofar as to the additional units proposed herein, as being that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 10,230 feet and 11,730 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Coronado Energy E&P Company, L.L.C.--Miller Land Co., Ltd. 10 No. 1 Well, located in Section 10, Township 13 North, Range 16 West, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.
5. To provide that for any horizontal well drilled within these proposed units, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, the distance to any unit boundary and offset well will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well and not based on the penetration point or terminus of the well in the Haynesville Zone.
6. To extend, except as in conflict herewith, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R, effective April 1, 2008, as amended and supplemented, and of all applicable Statewide Orders, to the proposed additional units.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to any of these proposals.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R, effective April 1, 2008.

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Portions of the acreage within the two (2) units proposed herein were included in units proposed by Applicant in an application dated August 26, 2008, which was originally scheduled for hearing on October 14, 2008, under Docket No. 08-1529. A counterplan to the units proposed in the application dated August 26, 2008, was filed by Chesapeake Operating, Inc., by letter dated September 29, 2008, and the hearing on the application was continued without date to allow the parties to attempt to resolve their differences. These efforts are ongoing, but by this filing Applicant hereby withdraws its proposals under Docket No. 08-1529.

Any pertinent data concerning this application will be available for inspection at the offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 3636 N. Causeway Blvd., Suite 204, Metairie, Louisiana 70002-7216. Any person wishing to inspect any such data should call Mr. Gilbert at (504) 834-8112 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the records of the Louisiana Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.


By letter dated May 27, 2009, Applicant gave notice, in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure, of its intention to apply for a public hearing concerning these proposals and a pre-application conference with respect to Applicant's proposals was tentatively scheduled for June 18, 2009. No request for the pre-application conference was received within the time provided in the Rules of Procedure; therefore, no conference will be held.

Attached hereto is a plat showing the proposed units (which is identical to the plat attached to the pre-application notice). Also attached hereto is a list of the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom a copy of this application is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list is being forwarded only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation. A copy of the list will be furnished by the undersigned to any party so requesting. A reasonable effort was made to obtain a complete list of Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing, and of the enclosed plat, at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of Bethany-Longstreet Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, a copy of the Legal Notice will be mailed to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

Finally, we enclose our check payable to the Commissioner of Conservation for the application fee.


