Applicant: Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC

Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of **Goodrich Petroleum Company, LLC** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SUMM in the Greenwood-Waskom Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create an additional single drilling and production unit of approximately 640 acres for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SUMM designated as the HA RA SUMM, Greenwood-Waskom Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat;
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said unit;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate a unit well for the proposed unit, if appropriate;
5. To designate Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. as the operator of the proposed unit, if appropriate;
6. To provide that with respect to future horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within the proposed unit, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, the distance to any unit boundary will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus.
7. To extend to the proposed unit, the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 270-MM-2, effective September 16, 2008;
8. To extend to the proposed unit, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order

No. 270-MM, effective June 19, 2007, as amended and supplemented by the 270-MM Series of Orders, and

9. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, in the Greenwood-Waskom Field was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 270-MM, effective June 19, 2007, and is hereby redefined INSOFAR AND ONLY INSOFAR as the unit proposed herein is concerned, in accordance with Office of Conservation Order No. 270-MM-2, effective September, 16, 2008.

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, the Commissioner of Conservation, the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation and all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties known to the applicant after a reasonable search were notified in writing in the pre-application notice dated May 27, 2009 that a conference to discuss the proposed application was tentatively scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 17, 2009. It was stated at that time that this conference would be held only if a request to confer were received by the undersigned within ten (10) calendar days after the date of the pre-application notice. No requests to confer were received either in writing or by telephone and, in accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the tentatively scheduled conference **WILL NOT BE HELD**.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the HA RA SUMM, Greenwood-Waskom Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, and a list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties to whom this notice is being sent. It is hereby certified that a reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties.

A copy of the list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties is not being mailed to those parties along with this hearing application. Should any such party desire a copy of this list, however, we will be glad to provide one upon request.

Upon receipt of the legal notice in the captioned matter, the notice will be posted, published and mailed in accordance with Rule 7 of the Rules of Procedure.
