Application is hereby made on behalf of Layline Petroleum LLC to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Richard Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bosco Field, Lafayette and St. Landry Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Richard Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bosco Field, Lafayette and St. Landry Parishes, Louisiana.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for this zone and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the unit so created, as may be appropriate.
4. To provide that the Richard Zone, Reservoir A, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the Reservoir by supplemental order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner.
6. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.

The Richard Zone, Reservoir A, in the Bosco Field, Lafayette and St. Landry Parishes, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that interval encountered between the measured depths of 8462' and 8688' in the Cayman Exploration- Arceneaux Heirs No. 1 Well (SN 153809) , located in Section 35, Township 8 South, Range 3 East, St. Landry Parish, Louisiana.

In addition to furnishing the legal notice to all Interested Parties, the applicant will provide for POSTING of the legal notice of the hearing and unit plat in a prominent place in the area of the Bosco Field, Lafayette and St. Landry Parishes, Louisiana, and will cause the legal notice of the hearing to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation published in the vicinity of the Bosco Field, Lafayette and St. Landry Parishes, Louisiana, at least fifteen (15) days before the hearing date.
