On behalf of COMSTOCK OIL & GAS-LOUISIANA, LLC, application is hereby made for a public hearing to receive evidence concerning the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Benson Field, DeSoto and Sabine Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To create seven (7) additional drilling and production units (to be designated as HA RA SUU thru HA RA SUZ and HA RA SUAA), as shown on the plat attached hereto, for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Benson Field, DeSoto and Sabine Parishes, Louisiana.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases, and other property interests within each of the proposed units, with allocation of production to the tracts within such units to be on the basis of surface acreage.
3. To designate Comstock Oil & Gas - Louisiana, LLC as unit operator and to designate unit wells for certain of the proposed units, if appropriate.
4. To redefine the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Benson Field, as that gas and condensate bearing interval between the depths of 10,037 feet and 11,644 feet (electric log measurements) in the Comstock - BSMC LA 12 HZ No. 1 Well located in Section 12, Township 10 North, Range 15 West, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, INsofar ONLY as to the proposed HA RA SUU thru HA RA SUZ and HA RA SUAA.
5. To provide that, with respect to future horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the proposed units and in the Benson Field, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary and between wells will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus.
6. To permit the Applicant to designate and utilize its BSMC LA 12 HZ No. 1 Well as the unit well for HA RA SUV; to designate and utilize its BSMC LA 7 HZ No. 1 Well and its Blackstone Mineral Co. LA 7 HZ No. 2 Well as the unit well and alternate unit well for HA RA SUV; and to drill, designate and utilize its proposed BSMC LA 17 HZ No. 1 Well as the unit well for HA RA SUAA, respectively, at the locations shown on the plat attached hereto.
7. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend the provisions of the 496-L Series of Orders to the proposed units.
8. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

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The Haynesville Zone, in the Benson Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 496-L, effective November 18, 2008, but shall be redefined as set forth above.

Pertinent data regarding this application will be available for inspection at the offices of Blanchard, Walker, O'Quin & Roberts, 15th Floor, Chase Tower, 400 Texas Street, Suite 1400, Shreveport, Louisiana 71101. Copies of such pertinent data can be obtained AT THE EXPENSE OF THE REQUESTING PARTY.

A list of the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties (as defined in the Revised Rules of Procedure) is attached hereto, and a copy of this Application, with the annexed plat, is being sent to each of such persons. A reasonable effort has been made to determine that the enclosed list includes all of the persons to whom this notice must be sent under the Revised Rules of Procedure. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation. However, the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it.

A Pre-Application Conference was held at the offices of Blanchard, Walker, O'Quin & Roberts, 15th Floor, Chase Bank Tower, 400 Texas Street, Shreveport, Louisiana, on June 18, 2009. In addition to the Applicant's representatives, said conference was attended by the parties shown on the attached attendance list. Following a presentation by Applicant's representatives as to the geological and other bases for its proposal, a general discussion ensued prior to adjournment. David Comeaux, representing Eagle Oil and Gas, stated that Eagle Oil and Gas may file a counterplan proposing that fractional Section 23, Township 10 North, Range 15 West, be included in the proposed HA RA SUU. It is anticipated that the hearing regarding the captioned matter will be contested as to the configuration of HA RA SUU.

A check in the amount of \$755.00 made payable to the Commissioner of Conservation is enclosed herewith as the statutory fee for holding the requested hearing.

This application is being filed in duplicate, and a copy hereof is being sent to Mr. James C. Broussard, Shreveport District Manager of the Office of Conservation, to all Pre-Application Conference Attendees and to each Interested Owner, Represented Party and Interested Party whose name is shown on the attached list.

You may have received this Hearing Application even though your property may or may not be included in the proposed units, because the Revised Rules of Procedure require us to attempt to also notify everyone owning an interest in the area "proximate to" the proposed units.

Your receipt of this Hearing Application does not require you to take any action. It is meant to notify you of these proceedings so that you have the opportunity to participate if you so desire.




TOLEDO BEND RESERVOIR
