Application is hereby made on behalf of **CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC.** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the **Caspiana Field**, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a pattern of drilling and production units was created by Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007, as amended and supplemented by certain Orders of the 191-H Series of Orders, including the unit designated HA RA SU55, created by Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H-31, effective December 16, 2008, to-wit:

1. To permit the applicant, Chesapeake Operating, Inc., to drill, designate and utilize the Chesapeake Operating, Inc. – Graham 34H No. 1 Well as the substitute unit well for HA RA SU55, located as shown on the attached plat, in exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007;

2. To the extent not inconsistent herewith, to continue in full force and effect the unit designated HA RA SU55, created by Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H-31, effective December 16 2008, and all pertinent provisions of Order No. 191-H, effective August 28 2007, as amended and supplemented by certain Orders of the 191-H Series of Orders; and
3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to this application as shown by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, in the Caspiana Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007, and was redefined as to the HA RA SU55 in Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H-31, effective December 16, 2008.


The proposed substitute unit well is necessary to drain a portion of the unit which cannot be drained by any existing well in the unit. The current unit well designated in Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H-31 was never drilled.

Finally, there is enclosed our check in the sum of \$755.00 payable to the Office of Conservation, representing the required hearing application fee.
