Application is hereby made on behalf of **DGH PETROLEUM, INC.**, (Applicant), to the Commissioner of Conservation for a Public Hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Nacatoch Sand, in the unit designated BLVU NAC FF19 SU, in the Bellevue Field, Bossier Parish, Louisiana:

1. To revise the existing BLVU NAC FF19 SU, established by Office of Conservation Order No. 196-C-11, effective March 5, 1986, for a thermal recovery unit in the Nacatoch Sand in the Bellevue Field, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, to include additional acreage as shown on the attached plat and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property within the proposed units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract to share in the unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit operator for the proposed revised unit.
4. To extend the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 196-C, effective October 1, 1970, and other applicable Statewide Orders to the proposed expanded unit being proposed herein, except as they may be in conflict herewith.
5. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem pertinent and appropriate.

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The Nacatoch Sand in the Bellevue Field, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 196-C, effective October 1, 1970.


