

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2009**, upon the application of **UNITED WORLD ENERGY CORP.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Marg H Zone, Reservoirs A and B**, in the Chalkley Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create two (2) single drilling and production units for the Marg H Zone, Reservoir A and the Marg H Zone, Reservoir B, designated as the MARG H RA SUA and MARG H RB SUA.
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said units.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in units production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To designate a unit operator and unit well for the MARG H RA SUA created herein.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Marg H Zone, Reservoir A is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 12,010' and 13,360' (electrical log measurements) in the Shell Oil Company-Lacassane No. C-1 Well (SN 74629), located in Section 14, Township 12 South, Range 6 West and is further defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 13,540' and 14,965' (electrical log measurements) in the Shell Oil Company-Lacassane No. B-3 Well (SN 101601), located in Section 23, Township 12 South, Range 6 West.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
