Application is hereby made on behalf of **JOHN J. WELSH**, (Applicant), to the Commissioner of Conservation for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Sand, Reservoir B, East Haynesville Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana:

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Sand, Reservoir B, in the East Haynesville Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana, such unit being designated HA RB SUP, shown on the attached plat and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property within the proposed units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract to share in the unit production on a surface basis of participation,
3. To designate John J. Welsh as the operator for the proposed HA RB SUP and the John J. Browning No. 3 Well as the unit well.
4. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 105-J-1, effective April 25, 1990, and other applicable Statewide Orders to the unit to be created hereby.
5. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem pertinent and appropriate.

Attached hereto is our check, made payable to the Office of Conservation, to cover the applicable hearing fee.


