Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of **The Meridian Resource & Exploration, LLC** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the J Sand, Reservoir C and K Sand, Reservoir E in the Weeks Island Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

J Sand, Reservoir C

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E and to create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 2.5 acres for the J Sand, Reservoir C designated as the J RC SUA, Weeks Island Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat;
2. The J Sand, Reservoir C in the Weeks Island Field is hereby defined as that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 11,635 feet and 11,719 feet (electrical log measurements) (11542' and 11626' VD) in the Meridian Resource & Exploration, LLC-Smith State Unit C No. 11 ST2 Well, located in Section 18, Township 14 South, Range 7 East, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

K Sand, Reservoir E

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E and to create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 1.2 acres for the K Sand, Reservoir E designated as the K RE SUA, Weeks Island Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached revised plat;
2. The K Sand, Reservoir E in the Weeks Island Field is hereby defined as that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 11,756 feet and 11,814 feet (electrical log measurements) (11662' and 11720' VD) in the Meridian Resource & Exploration, LLC-Smith State Unit C No. 11 ST2 Well, located in Section 18, Township 14 South, Range 7 East, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

For the above Sands

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the said units;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate a unit operator and unit well for the units created herein;
5. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoirs as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, a pre-application conference was held in Lafayette, Louisiana on August 16, 2010. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a list of the names and addresses of the parties who were in attendance at that conference.

The conference was opened by Mr. B. J. Duplantis. Mr. Jim Hardwick of James Hardwick & Associates presented the plan of applicant. Questions were asked and answered. There is a slight change in the southwestern boundary of the unit which is coincidental with Office of Conservation Order No. 146-AA-2. It is anticipated that there will be no opposition at the public hearing on this matter.






