Dear Mr. Commissioner:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **Forest Oil Corporation** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Woodardville Field, Red River Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) alternate unit wells for HA RA SUI, at the locations shown on the attached plat;
2. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) alternate unit wells for HA RA SUM, at the location shown on the attached plat;
3. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) alternate unit wells for HA RA SUO, at the locations shown on the attached plat;
4. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) alternate unit wells for HA RA SUP, at the location shown on the attached plat;
5. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A in the Woodardville Field underlying the above referenced units, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within the unit;
7. To grant a single unit allowable for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Woodardville Field underlying the above referenced units, and to permit the operator of the units to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the alternate unit wells, or from any combination at its option;
8. To confirm Forest Oil Corporation as operator of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Woodardville Field underlying the above referenced units;
9. To provide that all proposed wells will be cased and cemented and no perforations will be at a distance of less than 330 feet from the nearest unit boundary;
10. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation No. 990-D, effective July 15, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 990-D Series of Orders, shall remain in full force and effect;
11. To provide that with respect to horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in or to serve the proposed unit, where the horizontal lateral portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville

Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus, and

12. To consider such other matters relating to the subject unit as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A in the Woodardville Field, Bienville, Bossier and Red River Parishes, Louisiana was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 990-D, effective July 15, 2008.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, Woodardville Field, Red River Parish, Louisiana, and a list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties to whom this notice is being sent. It is hereby certified that a reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties.

A copy of the list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties is not being mailed to those parties along with this application. Should any such party desire a copy of this list, however, we will be glad to provide one upon request.


