

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2010**, upon the application of **MUNOCO COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Tew Lake Sand SUK**, in the Bryant Brake Field, Catahoula Parish, Louisiana.

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 608, effective February 1, 1963, as amended by Order No. 608-A-5, effective October 15, 1970, so as to permit the Applicant to drill, complete and designate their proposed wellbore-Munoco Company-McGee et al No. 1 Well as a substitute unit well for production of oil and/or gas from the Tew Lake Sand, within the unit designated TL SUK.
2. To grant status of the proposed wellbore-Munoco Company-McGee et al No. 1 Well as a substitute unit well for TL SUK Tract.
3. To determine that the requested completion wellbore will enable a more effective and efficient drainage of a portion of the reservoir which cannot otherwise be drained by any other well located therein, absent approval of the exception to spacing provision.
4. To designate Munoco Company as the operator of such substitute unit well.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Tew Lake Sand is defined as being that hydrocarbon bearing sand occurring in the interval between 4,300' and 4,358' (induction electric log measurement) in the Charles M. Nolan-J.M. Meyers No. 1 Well, located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 9 North, Range 7 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Monroe**, Louisiana.
