

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2010**, upon the application of **LEGGETT PETROLEUM, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **3,740' Sand, Reservoir A SUA, 3,750' Sand, Reservoir A SUA and 3,745' Zone, Reservoir A SUA**, in the Eunice Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve both the 3,740 RA SUA and 3,750 RA SUA and simultaneously create the 3,745' Zone Reservoir A SUA for the exploration for and production of oil and gas and to establish rules and regulations for the 3,745' Zone so created.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate the Leggett Petroleum, LLC. (formerly Great Southern Oil & Gas) Oscar Frey No. 11 as the proposed unit well and the Leggett Petroleum LLC's-Agnes Bischoff No. 4, the Oscar Frey No. 9 and the Gus Frey No. 2 as the proposed alternate unit wells. Additionally, Leggett Petroleum, LLC. is proposing an alternate well yet to be drilled in close proximity to the Great Southern Oil & Gas-Oscar Frey No. 10.
4. To designate Leggett Petroleum, LLC. as the unit operator for the proposed unit.
5. It is also requested that all future wells drilled and or completed both inside and outside the 3,745' Zone, be exempt from Statewide Order No. 29-E and to be located not less than 100' from the unit line.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the 3,745' Reservoir A SUA by Supplemental Order without necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 3,745' Zone is hereby identified as the interval from 3,728' to 3,868' in the Leggett Petroleum, LLC. (formerly Great Southern Oil & Gas) Agnes Bischoff No. 4 located in Section 24, Township 7 South, Range 1 West (SN 204027). The proposed zone encompasses the 3,740' and 3,750' sands identified by the Commissioner of Conservation Order Nos. 992-D and 992-G, respectively.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
