

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2010**, upon the application of **WILL-DRILL OPERATING, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Cotton Valley Davis Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Unionville Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana.

1. To redefine the Cotton Valley Davis Zone, Reservoir A, insofar and only insofar as to the existing unit CV DAVIS RA SU77, as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 8,500' and 9,428' (electrical log measurements) in the Will-Drill Operating LLC-Aswell No. 1 Well, located in Section 12, Township 19 North, Range 1 West.
2. To confirm the unit designated CV DAVIS RA SU77 as remaining in full force and effect as a drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Davis Zone, Reservoir A, as redefined in the manner set forth above.
3. To confirm Applicant as operator of and its Aswell No. 1 Well as the unit well for, CV DAVIS RA SU77.
4. To continue in full force and effect, except to the extent contrary herewith, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 206-E, effective December 13, 1978, as amended and supplemented by the Order No. 206-E Series of Orders and of all applicable Statewide Orders, to the unit CV DAVIS RA SU77.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Davis Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 206-E-35, effective December 14, 1993 and was redefined as to CV DAVIS RA SU77 in Order No. 206-E-73, effective May 25, 2010.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
