LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2010**, upon the application of **SHORELINE SOUTHEAST LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hackberry Zone, Reservoir B and Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir D**, in the Topsy Field, Allen Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from each of the following intervals: Hackberry Zone, Reservoir B and Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir D.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit for each interval with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend to the proposed additional unit for each interval all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 957-E-1, effective November 15, 2005, for the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir B and Order No. 957-C-3, effective November 15, 2005, for the Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir D and applicable Statewide Orders as appropriate.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hackberry Zone was defined in Order No. 957-E, effective January 18, 2005.

The Nonion Struma Zone was defined in Order No. 957-C-2, effective January 18, 2005.
