LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2010**, upon the application of **HILCORP ENERGY COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **CC-11 Sand, Reservoir B and CC-11 Sand, Reservoir D**, in the Lake Washington Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the CC-11 RB SUA as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 149-D-4, effective May 23, 1989 and to dissolve the CC-11 RD SUA, as established by Order No. 149-D-5, effective June 16, 1992, and simultaneously therewith, to create a revised unit each for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the CC-11 Sand, Reservoir B and CC-11 Sand, Reservoir D.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created.
3. To designate Hilcorp Energy Company as operator of the CC-11 RB SUA.
4. To designate the Hilcorp Energy Company-E. Cockrell Jr. No. 154 Well as the unit well for the CC-11 RB SUA.
5. To provide that the CC-11 Sand, Reservoir B and CC-11 Sand, Reservoir D, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The CC-11 Sand, Reservoir B was fully defined in Order No. 149-D-4, effective May 23, 1989.

The CC-11 Sand, Reservoir D was fully defined in Order No. 149-D-5, effective June 16, 1992.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
