Dear Sir:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Hilcorp Energy Company to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the CC-11 Sand, Reservoir B and the CC-11 Sand, Reservoir D, in the Lake Washington Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the CC-11 RB SUA, as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 149-D-4, effective May 23, 1989 and to dissolve the CC-11 RD SUA, as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 149-D-5, effective June 16, 1992, both in the Lake Washington Field, and simultaneously therewith, to create a revised unit each for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the CC-11 Sand, Reservoir B and the CC-11 Sand, Reservoir D, in the Lake Washington Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana.

2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created.

3. To designate Hilcorp Energy Company as operator of the CC-11 RB SUA.

4. To designate the Hilcorp Energy Company - E. Cockrell Jr. No. 154 Well as the unit well for the CC-11 RB SUA.

5. To provide that the CC-11 Sand, Reservoir B and the CC-11 Sand, Reservoir D, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.

6. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the reservoirs by supplemental orders and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner.

7. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.

The CC-11 Sand, Reservoir B, in the Lake Washington Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 149-D-4, effective May 23, 1989.

The CC-11 Sand, Reservoir D, in the Lake Washington Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 149-D-5, effective June 16, 1992.

In addition to furnishing the legal notice to all Interested Parties, the applicant will provide for POSTING of the legal notice of the hearing and unit plat in a prominent place in the area of the Lake Washington Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana, and will cause the legal notice of the hearing to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation published in the vicinity of the Lake Washington Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana, at least fifteen (15) days before the hearing date.


In compliance with the Rules of Procedure, a preapplication notice was given, but no request for a conference was received, and therefore, none was held.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties and proposed unit plat (being the same plat attached to the September 15, 2010 notice) are being furnished **ONLY** to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, said plat and the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting copies. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, there is enclosed our check on behalf of the applicant, Hilcorp Energy Company, in the sum of \$755.00 payable to the Office of Conservation and representing the required hearing application fee.


