Dear Mr. Commissioner:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C.** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SU64, SU65, SU70 and SU71, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana.

Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SU64 and SU65

1. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. to drill, designate and utilize two (2) alternate unit wells for the HA RA SU64 and one (1) alternate unit well for the HA RA SU65, such wells to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SU64 and SU65, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field which cannot be efficiently and economically be drained by any other well within the unit;
3. To grant a single unit allowable for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SU64 and SU65, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field and to permit the operator of the units to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the alternate unit wells, or from any combination at its option;
4. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. as operator of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SU64 and SU65, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field;
5. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R-31, effective June 9, 2009, as amended and supplemented by the 289-R Series of Orders, shall remain in full force and effect;
6. To consider such other matters relating to the subject unit as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SU70 and SU71

1. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. to drill, designate and utilize an alternate unit well each for the HA RA SU70 and HA RA SU71, such wells to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SU70 and SU71, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field which cannot be efficiently and economically be drained by any other well within the unit;
3. To grant a single unit allowable for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SU70 and SU71, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field and to permit the operator of the units to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the alternate unit wells, or from any combination at its option;
4. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Company, L.L.C. as operator of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SU70 and SU71, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field;
5. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R-46, effective July 14, 2009, as amended and supplemented by the 289-R Series of Orders, shall remain in full force and effect;
6. To consider such other matters relating to the subject unit as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, Bethany-Longstreet Field, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R, effective April 1, 2008, and was redefined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R-3, effective June 25, 2008.




