Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Leggett Petroleum, L.L.C. for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters.

1. To dissolve both the 3,740' RA SUA and the 3,750' RA SUA and simultaneously create the 3,745' Zone RA SUA for the exploration for and production of oil and gas and to establish rules and regulations for the 3,745' Zone so created;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
3. To designate the Leggett Petroleum, L.L.C. (Formerly Great Southern Oil & Gas) Oscar Frey No. 11 as the proposed unit well and the Leggett Petroleum L.L.C.'s – Agnes Bischoff No. 4, the Oscar Frey No. 9, and the Gus Frey No. 2 as the proposed alternate unit wells. Additionally, Leggett Petroleum, L.L.C. is proposing an alternate well yet to be drilled in close proximity to the Great Southern Oil & Gas – Oscar Frey No. 10.
4. To designate Leggett Petroleum, L.L.C. as the unit operator for the proposed unit;
5. It is also requested that all future wells drilled and or completed both inside and outside the 3,745' Zone, be exempt from Statewide Order 29-E and to be located not less than 100' from the unit line.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the 3,745' RA SUA by supplemental order without necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The 3,745' Zone, in the Eunice Field, Acadia Parish is hereby identified as the interval from 3,728' to 3,868' in the Leggett Petroleum, L.L.C. (Formerly Great Southern Oil & Gas) Agnes Bischoff No. 4 located in


Section 24, Township 7 South, Range 1 West (SN 204027). The proposed zone encompasses the 3,740' and 3,750' sands identified by the Commissioner of Conservation Orders 992-D & 992-G respectively.

A conference to discuss the proposed application and any opposition thereto was tentatively scheduled for 10:30 on Wednesday, September 22, 2010 at the Petroleum Club of Lafayette, 111 Heymann Blvd., Lafayette, Louisiana. It is noted, however, that no conference was requested, therefore none was held.

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


