Application is hereby made on behalf of **ALICE-SIDNEY OIL COMPANY, LIMITED PARTNERSHIP** (Applicant), to the Commissioner of Conservation for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A Ada Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana:

1. To permit the Applicant to designate and utilize the Alice Sidney Oil Company, Limited Partnership – Harvey No. 5 Well as an alternate unit well for the production of gas and condensate from the Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A, in the Ada Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana, in the unit designated HOSS A RA SUFF, in exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 99-M-1, effective October 1, 1973.
2. To find that an alternate unit well is needed on the HOSS A RA SUFF to assist in the efficient and effective drainage of the Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A, that cannot be drained by any other well located therein.
3. To permit the unit operator to produce the assigned unit allowable from the unit well, the alternate unit wells or from a combination there of at its discretion.
4. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem pertinent and appropriate.


