On behalf of COMSTOCK OIL & GAS-LOUISIANA, LLC, application is hereby made for a public hearing to receive evidence concerning the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Benson Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana:

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize one (1) alternate unit well in each of the units designated as HA RA SUGG thru HA RA SUII, HA RA SUV and HA RA SUW, at the locations shown on the plat attached hereto.
2. To explicitly find that the proposed alternate unit wells are in the interest of conservation and necessary to drain a portion of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Benson Field underlying HA RA SUGG thru HA RA SUII, HA RA SUV and HA RA SUW, respectively, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well in such units.
3. To provide that the unit allowables for HA RA SUGG thru HA RA SUII, HA RA SUV and HA RA SUW, respectively, may be produced from either the unit well, the alternate unit wells, or any combination thereof, at the operator's discretion.
4. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, in the Benson Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 496-L, effective November 18, 2008, but shall be redefined as set forth above.

Pertinent data concerning the intended application will be made available for inspection at the offices of the undersigned. Any person wishing to inspect such data should call the undersigned at (318) 221-6858 during normal business hours or write the undersigned at the above address, in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data can be obtained AT THE EXPENSE OF THE REQUESTING PARTY.

A list of the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties (as defined in the Revised Rules of Procedure) is attached hereto. A copy of this notice, with the annexed plat, is being sent to each of such persons. A reasonable effort has been made to determine that the enclosed list includes all of the persons to whom this notice must be sent under the Revised Rules of Procedure. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation. However, the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it.

A check in the amount of \$3,775.00 made payable to the Commissioner of Conservation is enclosed herewith as the statutory fee for holding the requested hearing.


