Dear Commissioner Welch,

Application is hereby made on behalf of Petrodome Operating Co., LLC to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Rob L Zone, Reservoir A & B, in the Lake Hatch Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Rob L Zone, Reservoir A & B in the Lake Hatch Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana, said proposed unit designated ROBU L RA SUA and ROBU L RB SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Petrodome Operating Co. LLC as operator of the proposed ROBU L RA SUA and ROBU L RB SUA.
4. To provide that any wells drilled to the Rob L Zone, Reservoir A & B shall be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Orders without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished by the Commissioner.

6. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.


The Rob L is hereby defined as per order 313-F-1 in the Kent Bayou Field as that interval from 18,644'-19,985' in the Union Pacific Resources Company- CL & F No. 3 well located in Sect. 7, T18S, R14E. The Rob L Zone in the Lake Hatch Field is hereby further defined as that interval from 16, 600'-17,500' in the Kelly Oil Wylie Heirs No. 1 well located in Sect. 85, T17S, R16E.

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure, a pre-application conference was held in Lafayette on Wednesday, January 20, 2010. Mr. Bob Duplantis and Mr. David Comeaux, representing Conoco Philips, state that they may present a counterproposal whereby they request the western unit not be formed and the acreage in Section 10 be removed from RA SUA. Opposition is expected at the hearing.
