Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **ENCANA OIL & GAS (USA) INC.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create one (1) drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Madden Branch Field, Red River Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated HA RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Madden Branch Field, within or outside the unit created herein, should be located no closer than 330 feet from existing unit lines and no closer than 660 feet from any wells on competitive units.
4. With respect to future horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within or to serve the unit created herein, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary and any offset well(s) shall be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus.
5. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Madden Branch Field, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 10,305 feet and 12,620 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Questar Exploration and Production Company (formerly Will-Drill Production Company, Inc.) – Sustainable Forests 28 No. 1 Well, located in Section 28, of Township 15 North, Range 9 West, Bienville Parish, Louisiana.





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
