

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 2, 2010**, upon the application of **CONOCOPHILLIPS COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Davis Zone, Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A and Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Ada Field, Bienville and Webster Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To authorize ConocoPhillips Company to drill, designate and utilize an alternate unit well on DAVIS SUQ at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To authorize ConocoPhillips Company to drill, designate and utilize two (2) additional alternate unit wells on each of HOSS A RA SUY and HOSS B RA SUY at the locations shown on the plats submitted with the application.
3. To authorize ConocoPhillips Company to drill, designate and utilize an additional alternate unit well on each of HOSS A RA SUHH and HOSS B RA SUHH at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
4. To establish that the proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to efficiently and economically drain portions of the Davis Zone, Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A and Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A, underlying these units which cannot be efficiently and economically produced by any existing well presently located on such units.
5. To approve exceptions as necessary to the well location provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 99 as to the Davis Zone and Order No. 99-M-1 as to the Hosston A and B Zones, Reservoir A, for the proposed alternate unit wells.
6. To authorize the unit allowable for each to be recovered from the existing wells located on the units, the proposed alternate unit wells, or from any combination thereof, at the discretion of the operator.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Davis Zone was initially defined in Order No. 99, effective on and after July 6, 1945, and redefined in Order No. 99-A, effective July 29, 1946.

The Hosston A Zone, Reservoir A and Hosston B Zone, Reservoir A were fully defined in Order No. 99-M-1, effective on and after October 1, 1973.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
