Dear Sir:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Clayton Williams Energy, Inc. to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Camerina-Miogyp Zone, Reservoir A, in the Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the CAM C RA SUA, as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 155-KKK, effective January 8, 2002 and to dissolve the MIOGYR RA SUA, as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 155-LLL, effective January 8, 2002, both in the Abbeville Field, and simultaneously therewith, to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Camerina-Miogyp Zone, Reservoir A, in the Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the unit so created, as may be appropriate.
4. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Camerina-Miogyp Zone, Reservoir A, within or outside of the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
5. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the Camerina-Miogyp Zone, Reservoir A, by supplemental order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner.
6. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.

The Camerina-Miogyp Zone, Reservoir A, in the Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 16,300' and 17,630' (electrical log measurements) in the Prairie Producing Company - S. J. Bellow No. 1 Well, located in Section 25, Township 12 South, Range 2 East, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

In addition to furnishing the legal notice to all Interested Parties, the applicant will provide for POSTING of the legal notice of the hearing and unit plat in a prominent place in the area of the Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, and will cause the legal notice of the hearing to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation published in the vicinity of the Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, at least fifteen (15) days before the hearing date.

Any pertinent data relating to the subject application can be obtained, **AT THE COST OF THE REQUESTING PARTY**, from Cambe Geological Services, 6300 Westpark, Suite 400, Houston, Texas 77057 (713-659-8363).

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure, a preapplication notice was given, but no request for a conference was received, and therefore, none was held.

There are attached hereto and made a part hereof a plat outlining the proposed unit and a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom this application is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties and proposed unit plat (being the same plat attached to the November 12, 2009 notice) are being furnished **ONLY** to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, said plat and the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting copies. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, there is enclosed our check on behalf of the applicant, Hilcorp Energy Company, in the sum of \$2265.00 payable to the Office of Conservation and representing the required hearing application fee.


