Application is hereby made on behalf of **ANADARKO E&P COMPANY, LP** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Austin Chalk Zone, Reservoir A, in the South Burr Ferry Field, Vernon Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated AUS C RA SUJ, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. Except as otherwise provided, to extend to the proposed additional unit all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 1409, effective January 8, 1997, as amended and supplemented by the 1409-A Series of Orders, and applicable statewide orders.
4. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Austin Chalk Zone, Reservoir A, in South Burr Ferry Field, Vernon Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1409, effective January 8, 1997.

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
Pursuant to the Rules of Procedure, pre-application notice was given; however, no request for the conference was received. Therefore, the conference tentatively scheduled for February 24, 2010, **WILL NOT BE HELD**. One minor change was made to the proposed unit on the Northwest side to accommodate a request by the Office of Mineral Resources. Except for that one change, the proposal is unchanged from that reflected in the prior notice.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the applicant's proposal, along with a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom a copy of this application is being mailed.
