Dear Commissioner Welsh:

By letter dated September 25, 2009 (the "Application"), **FOREST OIL CORPORATION ("Forest")** made application to your office for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order which would further define the unitized interval of a drilling and production unit created by Office of Conservation Order No. 75-J-1, effective June 3, 2008, for the Siphonina Davisi Zone, Reservoir B, in the West White Lake Field, designated SD RB SUA.

Pursuant to Rule 9 of the Revised Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings before the Commissioner of Conservation, Forest hereby amends the Application by requesting consideration of evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following additional matters related to the **Siphonina Davisi Zone, Reservoir B**, in the **West White Lake Field**, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, to-wit:

1. To dissolve the existing SD RB SUA and simultaneously therewith create a revised drilling and production unit for the Siphonina Davisi

Zone, Reservoir B, such unit also being designated SD RB SUA, said revised unit being shown on the attached plat;

2. To confirm Forest as operator of, and its State Lease 15038 No. 3 Well as the unit well for, SD RB SUA, whether or not it is revised as proposed herein;
3. To extend to the proposed unit, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 75-J-1, effective June 3, 2008, and all applicable Statewide Orders; and
4. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

In all other respects the Application shall remain the same, and to the extent necessary, the Application is hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof by reference. **The proposed unit revision is being proposed to correct very minor misplacements of several of the corners of the unit. The coordinates used for these corners, as presented by the applicant and adopted by Order No. 75-J-1, were used in error and Forest believes they should be located as shown on the attached plat in order to coincide with the corners of the State Leases included within the unit.**

Pursuant to the Commissioner's Rules of Procedure, IF REQUESTED WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS OF THE REVISED APPLICATION, Applicant will schedule a conference to discuss the Revised Application to be held at the Onebane Law Firm, 1200 Camellia Blvd., Suite 300, Lafayette, LA 70508.

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

Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **FOREST OIL CORPORATION**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Siphonina Davisi Zone, Reservoir B**, in the **West White Lake Field**, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were adopted and a single drilling and producing unit was created by Office of Conservation Order No.75-J, effective April 24, 2007, to-wit:

1. To further define the top of the Siphonina Davisi Zone, Reservoir B, as being that certain gas and condensate bearing zone with a top being encountered at a depth of 16,250 feet, electrical log measurement, in the Forest Oil Corporation – State Lease 15038 No. 3 Well, located in Section 3 Township 15 South, Range 2 West, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana; and

2. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Siphonina Davisi Zone, Reservoir B, in the West White Lake Field, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 75-J, effective April 24, 2007, and is hereby further defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone with a top being encountered at a depth of 16,250 feet, electrical log measurement, in the Forest Oil Corporation – State Lease 15038 No. 3 Well, located in Section 3 Township 15 South, Range 2 West, Vermillion Parish, Louisiana

The Applicant is seeking only to **further define** the Siphonina Zone, Reservoir B, by confirming the correlative top of the existing definition in the Forest Oil Corporation – State Lease 15038 No. 3 Well, which was recently drilled in the unit designated SD RB SUA. **We are not seeking to change the existing definition or redefine the zone, nor are we seeking to revise the unit boundaries.**


