Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of **Duncan Oil, Inc.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir C, Southeast Lunita Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 230 acres for the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir C, designated as the HBY RC SUA, Southeast Lunita Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat;
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said unit;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Hackberry Zone, Reservoir C in the Southeast Lunita Field is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 8,400 feet and 9,090 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Samedan (Exxon)-Labokay No. 1 Well located in Section 2, Township 9 South, Range 12 West, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, a pre-application conference was held in Lafayette, Louisiana on February 18, 2010. Attached hereto and made a part

The conference was opened by Mr. B. J. Duplantis. Mr. W. H. Robbins of W. H. Robbins & Associates presented the plan of applicant. Questions were asked and answered. It is anticipated that there will be no opposition at the public hearing on this matter.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the HBY RC SUA, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana, and a list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties to whom this notice is being sent. 
