

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 23, 2010**, upon the application of **FOREST OIL CORPORATION**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Woodardville Field, Red River Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) additional alternate unit wells for HA RA SUF, at the locations shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) alternate unit wells for HA RA SUH, at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
3. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) additional alternate unit wells for HA RA SUJ, at the locations shown on the plat submitted with the application.
4. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) alternate unit wells for HA RA SUK, at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
5. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) alternate unit wells for HA RA SUL, at the locations shown on the plat submitted with the application.
6. To designate a unit well and to permit the application to drill, designate and utilize three (3) alternate unit wells for HA RA SUQ, at the locations shown on the plat submitted with the application.
7. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain of portion of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, underlying the above referenced units, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within the unit.
8. To grant a single unit allowable for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, underlying the above referenced units, and to permit the operator of the units to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the alternate unit wells, or from any combination at its option.
9. To confirm Forest Oil Corporation as operator of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, underlying the above referenced units.
10. That all proposed wells will be cased and cemented and no perforations will be at a distance of less than 330 feet from the nearest unit boundary.
11. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 990-D-2, effective September 30, 2008, shall remain in full force and effect.
12. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A was fully defined in Order No. 990-D-2, effective September 30, 2008.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
