**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2010**, upon the application of **HILCORP ENERGY COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **70 Zone, Reservoir A, 70 Zone, Reservoir B and 70 Zone, Reservoir C**, in the Caillou Island Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the CI UPR 70 R094 SU, as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 411-K-3, effective March 26, 1981; the CI UPR 70-D R091 SU, as established by Order No. 41-EEEE, effective April 23, 1986; the CI MID 70 R093 SU, as established by Order No. 411-L-3, effective March 26, 1981; the CI LWR 70 R093 SU, as established by Order No. 411-Q-2, effective December 13, 1984; and the CI L70-B RBB1 SU, as established by Order No. 411-M-1, effective December 15, 1976; simultaneously therewith, to create three (3) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the 70 Zone, Reservoir A, 70 Zone, Reservoir B and 70 Zone, Reservoir C.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the 70 Zone, Reservoir A, a unit operator, a unit well and three alternate unit wells for the 70 Zone, Reservoir B, and a unit operator, a unit well and two alternate unit wells for the 70 Zone, Reservoir C.
4. To provide that the operator of the 70 Zone, Reservoir A, 70 Zone, Reservoir B and 70 Zone, Reservoir C, can produce the unit allowable from the unit wells, the alternate unit wells or any combination thereof.
5. To provide that the 70 Zone, Reservoir A, 70 Zone, Reservoir B and 70 Zone, Reservoir C, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Orders and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 70 Zone, Reservoirs A, B and C are hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between 12,873' and 13,170' electric log measured depths (12,866' and 13,162' tvd) in the Hilcorp Energy Company (formerly Texaco)-SL 301 No. 346 Well, located in Township 23 South, Range 19 East.
