LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2010**, upon the application of **JORDAN OIL COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **9,800' Zone, Reservoir B**, in the East Moss Lake Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 9,800' Zone, Reservoir B.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the 9,800' Zone, Reservoir B, designated 9800 RB SUA.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To designate Jordan Oil Company as operator of the proposed 9800 RB SUA and their Reynolds Metals No. 1 Well as the unit well.
5. To provide that any wells drilled to the above mentioned zone, within or outside of the proposed unit, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
6. To allow the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoir by Supplemental Order, without the necessity of a public hearing should the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 9,800' Zone was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 102-S. Reservoir B is hereby further defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the electrical log measured depths of 9,270' (9,114' tvd) and 11,072' (10,524' tvd) in the Jordan Oil Company-Reynolds Metals (Bergstedt-Kuttner) No. 1 Well, located in Section 9, Township 11 South, Range 9 West.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
