

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 12, 2010**, upon the application of **CLAYTON WILLIAMS ENERGY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Lower Hosston Formation, Reservoir A**, in the Terryville Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create two (2) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Lower Hosston Formation, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with allocation of production to the tracts within each such unit to be on the basis of surface acreage.
3. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Lower Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, within or outside of the unit created herein, should be located no closer than 330 feet from any unit line and no closer than 1320 feet between wells drilling to, completed in, or for which a permit shall have been granted to drill to the Lower Hosston Formation, Reservoir A.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Lower Hosston Formation, Reservoir A is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval between the depths of 7,090' and 8,209' (electric log measurements) in the Chevron Oil Company (California Company)-Maude H Mitchell 2 No. 1 Well (SN 86781) located in Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 3 West.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
