Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **ENCANA OIL & GAS (USA) INC.** for the calling of public hearings, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters:

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, all in Zwolle Field, Sabine Parish, Louisiana, said units designated CV RA SUG and HA RA SUG, respectively, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To extend to the proposed additional units all pertinent provisions of the orders to be issued as a result of a hearing held on November 3, 2009, under Docket Nos. 09-1158 and 09-1159 for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, respectively.
4. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Zwolle Field, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the measured depths of 10,280 and 11,900 feet (electric log measurements) in the Shell Exploration

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and Production Co. – Olympia Minerals No. 26 No. 1 Well, located in Section 26, Township 9 North, Range 12 West, Sabine Parish, Louisiana.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Zwolle Field, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the measured depths of 11,900 and 13,395 feet (electric log measurements) in the Shell Exploration and Production Co. – Olympia Minerals No. 26 No. 1 Well, located in Section 26, Township 9 North, Range 12 West, Sabine Parish, Louisiana.



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
