LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 20, 2010**, upon the application of **BLOCK "T" PETROLEUM, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **9,000' Zone, Reservoir A**, in the South Bayou Mallet Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to designate and utilize the former Amerada Petroleum Corporation-James Turner No. 1 Well as an alternate unit well for the 9000 RA SUB, such well to be at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application in exception to the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E and the 271-U Series of Office of Conservation Orders.
2. To find that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the 9,000' Zone, Reservoir A, underlying 9000 RA SUB, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well within the unit.
3. To grant a single unit allowable for the 9000 RA SUB and to permit the operator of the unit to produce said unit allowable from the unit well or the proposed alternate unit well, or from a combination of such wells in the unit, at its option.
4. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of the 271-U Series of Orders shall remain in force and effect.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 9,000' Zone, Reservoir A was previously defined in Order No. 271-U, effective December 6, 2007.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
