("CHESAPEAKE")** made application to your office for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order which would create an additional drilling and production unit for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Red River-Bull Bayou Field.





Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC.**, for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Red River-Bull Bayou Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana**, for which rules and regulations were established and a pattern of drilling and production units was created by Office of Conservation Order No. 109-X-2, effective August 19, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 109-X Series of Orders, to-wit:

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such unit to be designated HA RA SUXX;
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;

3. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of, and a unit well for the proposed unit, if appropriate;
4. That with respect to future horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the proposed unit, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary and any offset well(s) should be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;
5. To extend to the proposed unit, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 109-X-2, effective August 19, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 109-X Series of Orders, and all applicable Statewide Orders; and
6. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, in the Red River-Bull Bayou Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 109-X, effective June 25, 2008.




