

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 18, 2010**, upon the application of **MANNON L. WALTERS, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **7,450' Zone, Reservoir B, 7,080' Sand, Reservoir A and 7,040' Sand, Reservoir B**, in the Lapeyrouse Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the unit for the 7,080' Sand, Reservoir A, designated 7080 RA SUA, as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 416-NN, effective July 28, 1982.
2. To dissolve the unit for the 7,040' Sand, Reservoir B, designated 7040 RB SUA, as established by Order No. 416-HH-3, effective July 28, 1982.
3. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the 7,450' Zone, Reservoir B.
4. To create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the 7,450' Zone, Reservoir B.
5. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
6. To designate the Mannon L. Walters, Inc.-Darsey et al No. 1 Well as the unit well at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
7. To designate Mannon L. Walters, Inc. as the unit operator.
8. To provide that any future wells drilled to the 7,450' Zone, Reservoir B shall be exempt from the well spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
9. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by Supplemental Order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
10. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 7,450' Zone, Reservoir B is hereby defined as that oil bearing zone encountered between the electric log depths of 7,070' and 8,054' (6,608'-7,478' tvd) in the Mannon L. Walters, Inc.-Darsey et al No. 1 Well (WSN 240493), located in Section 65, Township 20 South, Range 18 East.

The 7,080' Sand, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 416-NN, effective July 28, 1982.

The 7,040' Sand, Reservoir B was defined in Order No. 416-HH-3, effective July 28, 1982.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
