LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **THURSDAY, JUNE 3, 2010**, upon the application of **SWEPI LP**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston Formation, Reservoir C, Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir B and Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Red River Bull Bayou Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

HOSSTON FORMATION, RESERVOIR C

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hosston Formation, Reservoir C said unit to be designated HOSS RC SUG, as shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend to the proposed additional unit all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 109-N-5, effective September 29, 2004, as amended and supplemented by the 109-N Series of Orders, and applicable Statewide Orders.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston Formation, Reservoir C was previously defined in Order No. 109-N-5, effective September 29, 2004.

COTTON VALLEY FORMATION, RESERVOIR B

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir B said unit to be designated CV RB SUR, as shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend to the proposed additional unit all pertinent provisions of Order No. 109-S-4, effective August 5, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 109-S Series of Orders, and applicable Statewide Orders.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir B was previously defined in Order No. 109-S-4, effective August 5, 2008.

HAYNESVILLE ZONE, RESERVOIR A

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A said unit to be designated HA RA SU57, as shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend to the proposed additional unit all pertinent provisions of Order No. 109-X-2, effective August 19, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 109-X Series of Orders, and applicable Statewide Orders.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Zone was previously defined in Order No. 109-X, effective June 25, 2008.
