Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of **Forest Oil Corporation**, for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, Zwolle Field, Sabine Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 640 acres for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SUS, designated as the HA RA SUS, Zwolle Field, Sabine Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat;
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, SUS;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate a unit operator and unit well for the unit created herein;
5. To provide that, with respect to future horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within the proposed unit where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, the distance to any unit boundary will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;

6. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A in the Zwolle Field, Sabine Parish, Louisiana is defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 11,436 feet and 12,190 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Shell Oil-Boise Southern No. 1 well, located in Section 7, Township 7 North, Range 13 West, Sabine Parish, Louisiana.

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, the Commissioner of Conservation, the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation and all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties known to the applicant after a reasonable search were notified in writing in the pre-application notice dated April 9, 2010 that a conference to discuss the proposed application was tentatively scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, April 30, 2010. It was stated at that time that this conference would be held only if a request to confer were received by the undersigned within ten (10) calendar days after the date of the pre-application notice. No requests to confer were received either in writing or by telephone and, in accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the tentatively scheduled conference **WILL NOT BE HELD**.




