LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JUNE 29, 2010**, upon the application of **SAMSON CONTOUR ENERGY E&P, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A and Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Chemard Lake Field, DeSoto and Natchitoches Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To create three (3) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the following: Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to extend to the proposed additional units all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 700-D-1, effective April 28, 2009, for the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, Order No. 700-E-1, effective April 28, 2009, for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and Order No. 700-G, effective April 28, 2009, for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, and all applicable Statewide Orders.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston Formation, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 700-D-1, effective April 28, 2009.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 700-E-1, effective April 28, 2009.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 700-G, effective April 28, 2009.
