

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JUNE 15, 2010**, upon the application of **J-W OPERATING COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A and Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Elm Grove Field, Bossier Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create three (3) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within these proposed units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit operator of and a unit well for, each of the proposed units as may be appropriate.
4. To provide that with respect to any horizontal well drilled to the Haynesville Zone within the proposed units, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, the distance to any unit boundary or offset well will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus of the well in the Haynesville Zone.
5. To redefine the Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, insofar and only insofar as to the existing units LCV RA SUR, LCV RA SUS and LCV RA SU60, as shown on the plat submitted with the application, as being that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 10,030' and 10,670' (electrical log measurements) in the J-W Operating Company-Cohort Energy et al 22 No. 1 Well, located in Section 22, Township 16 North, Range 13 West.
6. To expand the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 361-31, effective August 21, 2001, which approved down hole combination of production from the Hosston Zone, Reservoir A, the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and the Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, underlying the identical units HOSS RA SU107, CV RA SU127 and LCV RA SU60, so as to include production from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, underlying the proposed unit HA RA SU123, in any well in which the ownership interest in the units from which production is combined down hole are identical.
7. To expand the provisions of Order No. 361-14, effective April 9, 1998, and Order No. 361-45, effective April 29, 2003, which approved down hole combination of production from the Hosston Zone, Reservoir A, the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, and the Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, underlying the identical units HOSS RA SU129, CV RA SU124 and LCV RA SUR, so as to include production from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, underlying the proposed unit HA RA SU124, in any well in which the ownership interest in the units from which production is combined down hole are identical.
8. To extend, except as in conflict herewith, the provisions of Order No. 361-L, effective July 29, 2008, as supplemented and amended by the 361-L Series of Orders, and of all applicable Statewide Orders, to the proposed additional units for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A.
9. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Lower Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 361-E, effective July 16, 1996.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 361-L, effective July 29, 2008.
