**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 19, 2010**, upon the application of **SWIFT ENERGY OPERATING, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **244 Zone, Reservoir A and E Zone, Reservoir B**, in the Lake Washington Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana.

**244 ZONE, RESERVOIR A**

1. To dissolve the existing drilling and production unit created as the CM 244 Zone, Reservoir A, by Office of Conservation Order No. 149-GGG-1, effective January 6, 2009, and to simultaneously create a revised single drilling and production unit, designated as the CM 244 RA SUA.
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the said unit.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To confirm Swift Energy Operating, LLC as operator and the Swift Energy Operating, LLC-Cockrell-Moran No. 244 Well as the unit well for the unit created herein.
5. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of 149-GGG Series of Orders shall remain in full force and effect.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 244 Zone, Reservoir A was previously defined by Order No. 149-GGG, effective October 1, 2003 and revised and redefined by Order No. 149-GGG-1, effective January 6, 2009.

**E ZONE, RESERVOIR B**

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E and to create a single drilling and production unit for the E Zone, Reservoir B.
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the said unit.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To designate a unit and a unit well for the unit created herein.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The E Zone, Reservoir B is hereby defined as that oil and gas bearing zone between the depths of 3,268' and 3,724' vertical depth (-3229' to -3675' subsea) in the electric log of the Swift Energy-Cockrell Moran No. 325 Well (SN 228526), located in Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 26 East.
