LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JUNE 29, 2010**, upon the application of **DYNAMIC EXPLORATION PARTNERS, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Amphistegina F Sand, Reservoir B, Cristellaria I Sand, Reservoir A, and Amphistegina-Cristellaria Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Grand Cheniere Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the existing AMPH F RB SUA, established by Office of Conservation Order No. 199-F-2, effective March 1, 1973.
2. To dissolve the existing CRIS I RA SUA, established by Order No. 199-B-2, effective January 9, 1990.
3. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Amphistegina-Cristellaria Zone, Reservoir A, said unit designated AMPH-CRIS RA SUA.
4. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
5. To provide that any wells drilled to the Amph-Cris Zone, Reservoir A, within or outside the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Amph-Cris Zone, Reservoir A by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Amphistegina F Sand, Reservoir B was previously defined in Order No. 199-F-2, effective March 1, 1973.

The Cristellaria I Sand, Reservoir A was previously defined in Order No. 199-B-2, effective January 9, 1990.

The Amphistegina-Cristellaria Zone, Reservoir A is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between the depths of 8,433' and 10,750' (electrical log measurements) in the Miller-Swire No. 1 Well (SN 104190), located in Section 49, Township 15 South, Range 5 West.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
