

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JUNE 8, 2010**, upon the application of **INDIGO MINERALS, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Haynesville Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Haynesville Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To designate D&S Oil and Gas Operators, Inc. as operator of the HA RA SUX; JE Yates A No. 1 Well (SN 80817), and as operator of the HA RA SUZ; HN Green No. 1 Well (SN 72554), said wells being located as shown on the plat submitted with the application and serving as the unit wells for HA RA SUX and HA RA SUZ respectively.
2. To confirm Applicant as operator of the HA RA SUX; Yates et al No. 2-Alt Well (SN 222343) and as operator of the HA RA SUZ; Nora Greene Jones No. 1-Alt Well (SN 223492), said wells being located as shown on the plat submitted with the application and serving as alternate unit wells for HA RA SUX and HA RA SUZ respectively.
3. To authorize Applicant to report production from the alternate unit wells described above separately from the unit wells.
4. To continue in effect the current allowables assigned to HA RA SUX and HA RA SUZ, which may be produced from either the unit well, the alternate unit well, or from a combination of both wells, with allocation of the unit allowable between the wells to be arranged between the operators of the respective wells.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Sand, Reservoir A was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 35-R, effective February 5, 1986.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
