

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JUNE 29, 2010**, upon the application of **J-W OPERATING COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A and Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Grand Cane Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A.
2. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of these proposed units in accordance with Section 10, Title 30 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To designate a unit operator of and a unit well for, each of the proposed units as may be appropriate.
5. To provide that with respect to any horizontal well drilled to the Haynesville Zone within the proposed unit HA RA SUS, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, the distance to any unit boundary or offset well will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus of the well in the Haynesville Zone.
6. To extend, except as in conflict herewith, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 342-H, effective June 22, 2004, as amended and supplemented by the 342-H Series of Orders, and all applicable Statewide Orders, to the proposed additional unit for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A.
7. To extend, except as in conflict herewith, the provisions of Order No. 342-K, effective March 3, 2009, as amended and supplemented by the 342-K Series of Orders, and of all applicable Statewide Orders, to the proposed additional unit for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A.
8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 342-H, effective June 22, 2004.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 342-K, effective March 3, 2009.
