

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **WEDNESDAY, JULY 7, 2010**, upon the application of **EXCO OPERATING COMPANY, LP.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Kingston Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the Applicant to drill, designate and utilize three (3) horizontal laterals for HA RA SUA and HA RA SUB as additional alternate unit wells for the production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such unit and proposed horizontal laterals shown on the plats submitted with the application.
2. To find that alternate unit wells are necessary on the HA RA SUA and HA RA SUB to assist in draining a portion of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, that cannot be drained by any other well located within each unit.
3. That with respect to the proposed horizontal wells to be drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within or to serve the HA RA SUA and HA RA SUB, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary and any offset well(s) should be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforations in the well and not based on the penetration point.
4. To permit the unit operator to produce the assigned unit allowable from the unit well, the alternate unit wells or from a combination of all wells, at its discretion.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 376-D, effective November 18, 2008.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
