Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of **Dunn Exploration Company, LLC** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the Duhon 1-2 Zone, Reservoir A and Duhon 1 Sand, Reservoir J, in the Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

**Duhon 1-2 Zone, Reservoir A**

1. To dissolve the existing drilling and production unit created as the Duhon 1-2 Zone, Reservoir A, by Office of Conservation Order No. 155-XXX, effective February 9, 2010.

**Duhon 1 Sand, Reservoir J**

1. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 65 acres for the Duhon 1 Sand, Reservoir J, designated as the DUHON 1 RJ SUA in the Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat;
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said sand unit;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate and unit operator and unit well for the unit created herein;
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the sand and reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of each reservoir changes and evidence to justify

such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation, and

7. To consider such other matters which may be pertinent to this application as shown by the evidence presented at the hearing held on this matter.

The Duhon 1 Sand, Reservoir J, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 10,795 feet and 10,970 feet (10,702' and 10,866' TVD) (electrical log measurements) in the Dunn Exploration Company, LLC-Eagle Rock No. 1 Well, located in Section 58, Township 12 South, Range 3 East, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

The Commissioner of Conservation has waived the twenty (20) day per-application notice requirement provided for in Rule 3 of the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation and that rule is not applicable to this hearing application.


